

Opportunities for CUPB students with the University of Dundee

Introduction and description of articulation programme

CUPB Business Administration students studying: **Accounting, Energy Economics Financial Management, International Economics and Trade, Management Information Systems and Marketing** are offered the opportunity to study in the UK at the University of Dundee for the 3rd or 4th year of their undergraduate programme.

After successfully completing all the requirements of both CUPB and UoD students will graduate with a CUPB Bachelor degree and receive a University Certificate of Performance by UoD.

CUPB students who successfully complete their final year at UoD will be eligible to enter a wide range of one-year masters programmes (see table) and be awarded an MSc degree by the University of Dundee.

Entry Requirements

Successful completion of two or three years on appropriate CUPB School of Business Administration undergraduate courses listed with:

- Average score minimum 75%
- o Plus meeting UoD English Language requirements (see website below)^{a)}
